This document outlines the description of the agreement between PlaneSense INC. and CHI Aerospace Fuels, LLC. (d.b.a CHI Aerospace), eligibility requirements and program policies.

ELIGIBILITY

Any flight instructor that is currently employed by CHI Aerospace is eligible for this program. CFII is not required, but highly desirable.

REQUIREMENTS

CHI Aerospace and PlaneSense INC. have a formal agreement that allows CHI Aerospace CFI's to take advantage of a career pathway program that guarantees them an automatic interview at PlaneSense INC, so long as they meet the following requirements:

Candidates must...

- have a minimum of 820 hours total flight time;
- be recommended by the CHI Aerospace General Manager and Chief Pilot;
- possess a FAA Single Engine Commercial Pilot or ATP Certificate with instrument ratings;
- possess a FAA First or Second Class medical;
- and have a minimum of 500 hours pilot-in-command (PIC) time.

**Any candidate who interviews with PlaneSense Inc. under this agreement must meet the same standards for employment as other candidates of PlaneSense Inc.*

CHI AEROSPACE POLICIES

In order to remain eligible for this program, candidates must...

- be an active team member at CHI;
- be in good standing with CHI Aerospace;
- and have no outstanding payments, or violations in regards to CHI Aerospace's policies.
