BS in Aviation Management

Purdue Global's aviation management program combines aviation operations and business management skills to develop you for managerial-level positions. Offered 100% online, you'll gain specialized knowledge of the aviation industry, taught by faculty with years of aviation industry experience as pilots, entrepreneurs, executives, managers, and military personnel. This program can also accept eligible transfer credits for those who hold FAA certificates and ratings.

If you hold an Aviation Maintenance Technician (Aviation Mechanic) with Airframe and Powerplant certification, you may qualify to receive up to 77 open elective credits to be used toward a Purdue Global undergraduate degree. For those that hold only the "A" or "P" certification, you may receive up to 57 or 52 open elective credits, respectively. BS in Professional Flight and BS in Aviation Management allow 18 and 41 open elective credits, respectively.
